²⁵ "Miraculous signs will occur in the sun, moon, and stars. The nations of the earth will be deeply troubled and confused because of the roaring and tossing of the sea. ²⁶ People will faint as they fearfully wait for what will happen to the world. The Second Coming of Christ is an amazing time for the entire world to acknowledge, the phenomenal appearance

of flood waters in every place on earth was a great feat that only the Lord could cause. Hail Haniwa, the Kingdom of the Heavens has arrived. What passage in the Bible tells us another feature of the Second Coming of Christ? At John 4:25 (Living Bible) 25 The woman said, "Well, at least I know that the Messiah will come—the one they call Christ and when he does, he will explain everything to us." This information in this passage is very important to us because it expresses that God does intend to explain things to all the chosen ones. Since the Kingdom of the Heavens cannot be observed by the human eye stated in Luke 17:20-21 God must find a detailed way that announces the kingdom that fits divine ways. Almighty God is not human the Kingdom rules over the realm of mankind and is formulated to fit the understanding of people everywhere no matter what language is spoken. For This reason a riddle was placed on earth long before the kingdom's arrival that will accomplish the will of God in explaining the future to everyone. What passage in the Bible helps us acknowledge the need to find a safe place to leave the riddle until the Kingdom's arrival? In the modern times what is the best information that can describe the leading oriental nation? Going online it is explains that: Which Asian country is the most advanced? Japan. Japan, one of the world's most literate and technically advanced nations, is an East Asian country made up of four main islands. In acknowledging this information God has found the country where the riddle for the announcement of the Kingdom of the Heavens will be kept safe. In taking a closer look at the development of the Japanese culture it is explained:

When was the Yamato period in Japan?

The Yamato Period, commonly broken into two separate eras: the Kofun ("tumulus") Era, from 250 to 538, and the Asuka Era, from 538 to 710, saw the emergence of a central governing power in the west of Japan, centered around the Yamato Province (highlighted in yellow on the map).

What is Yamato in Japanese culture?

Yamato, a peninsula on the southwestern-most portion of the **Japanese island of Honshu**, has historically been a region of great cultural influence. Yamato developed as a center of political power in the fertile Kinai plain of Japan from 300 to 710 A.D.

When did the Yamato clan start?

6th century

The Yamato clan (和氏), also known as Yamato no Fuhito (和史), was an immigrant clan active in Japan since the Kofun period (250–538), according to the history of Japan laid out in the Nihon Shoki.

Why was the Yamato clan important?

Yamato links to the mainland and the Liu Sung Dynasty in 425 and 478 were facilitated by the maritime knowledge and diplomatic connections of China and the Three Kingdoms Period of the Korean peninsula. Many important figures in Japanese history were immigrants from East Asia.

What came after the Asuka period?

The second stage of Buddhist art, coming after the Asuka (cultural) period, is known as the **Hakuhō culture** (白鳳文化, Hakuhō Bunka), and is generally dated from the Taika Reform (646) until the moving of the capital to Nara in 710.

Is Yamato Chinese or Japanese?

The Yamato clan set up Japan's first and only dynasty. The clan became the ruling faction in the area, and incorporated **native Japanese**, **Chinese and Korean migrants**. The clan leaders also elevated their own belief system that featured ancestor worship into a national religion known as Shinto.

How did the Yamato clan affect Japan?

How did the Yamato clan influence future Japanese government? The Yamato clan dominated an area on Honshu that became the central area of Japanese government. The clan also established Japan's first and only dynasty.

What was Japan's old name?

Before Nihon came into official use, Japan was known as **Wa** (**倭**) **or Wakoku** (**倭国**). Wa was a name early China used to refer to an ethnic group living in Japan around the time of the Three Kingdoms Period.

Who lived in Japan before the Japanese? Japan's indigenous people, **the Ainu**, were the earliest settlers of Hokkaido, Japan's northern island

What happened in the Kofun period?

The Kofun period recorded Japan's earliest political centralization, when the Yamato clan rose to power in southwestern Japan, established the Imperial House, and helped control trade routes across the region.

Why is Yamato important to Japan?

In the seventh century, the Yamato **transformed the government of Japan based on influences from China**. The Yamato sovereign became an imperial ruler supported by court and administrative officials. The uji class was stripped of land and military power, but given official posts and stipends.

Now in returning to the purpose of placing a riddle within the advanced nation of the Japanese, the announcement of the Kingdom of the Heavens can be explained at the Second Coming of Christ. During the modern times since the written language was necessary for scholars to study the culture of a nation, the key significance of Haniwa sculptures used in funeral rituals as thought of because of its presence on the graves. Because there was no written language system the riddle that evolved among the ancient elite class of the Yamato Clans was left for God to explain. How do the scholars express the meaning of Haniwa?

What's the meaning of haniwa?

Definition of haniwa

: large hollow baked clay sculptures placed on ancient Japanese burial mounds.

What is the purpose of the haniwa?

The Haniwa (埴輪) are terracotta clay figures that were made for **ritual use** and buried with the dead as funerary objects during the Kofun period (3rd to 6th centuries AD) of the history of Japan.

Where are haniwa placed?

Haniwa were placed at the top of the burial mound, in the center, along the edges, and at the entrance of the burial chamber of enormous tombs constructed for the ruling elite during the Tumulus, or Kofun

How did haniwa figures function at grave sites during the Kofun period?

The intended function of such sculptures, including this hollow figure with a necklace, earring, and belt, is still debated. One theory suggests that haniwa models served to mark and protect the boundary between the realms of the living and the dead.

Why was there no religious connection between the funeral ritual of Haniwa

Sculptures and a church ritual for funerals in general? The presence of haniwa sculptures appear during the 3^{rd} to the 8^{th} century of ancient Japanese history during the kofun periods. The development of religion such as Confucius and Shinto did not appear until much later in the Japanese cultures. This is explained by the scholars that researched this history. A connection could not be established because it had not been invented yet the same as the writing system had not been created yet during the time of the Haniwa figures. This is again how God wanted the riddle to be placed in a raw Japanese culture that was still in developmental stages. In the dictionary what is the best word to describe the riddle that God used for the Haniwa figures? The best words are Conundrum = a confusing and difficult problem or question. A question asked for amusement, typically one with a pun in its answer; a riddle. The next word that best describes a riddle

would be a **Secret** = not known or seen or not meant to be known or seen by others; Something that is kept or meant to be kept unknown or unseen by others; something that is not properly understood; a mystery. The final meaning for a Riddle is Undisclosed = not revealed or made known publicly. So another key point is that God also led the scholars into researching the Haniwa figures that evolved with time and getting the scholars to realize that the figures places on top of the graves of the elite during the Yamato period was also a construction of something meant for the future of the dead.

During the modern era with the arrival of the Kingdom of the Heavens how was the Haniwa riddle explained by God? It all has a very simple meaning that can easily be followed by people everywhere. As a young girl I used to belong to a Christian youth boys and girls club called Chum's

that began in the 1970's. This club was like an afterschool kind of thing to keep kids off the streets. I went faithfully every week and they had songs, games, and Bible study. I remember fondly the Christian songs that we used to sing. I still sing these songs to myself even today. Anyway one of the Christian songs from Chum's Club was Hail Haniwa that was often sung within the club. I grew up and forgot all about Chum's Club but as I told you I still sing the Christian songs. I own Hollywood as an heir and one day in 2021 I was watching the TV Show See that comes on Apple TV App. I instantly remembered the Chum's Club Christian song Hail Haniwa and started singing it to myself as I watched the show. In research of Chum's Club I found that they no longer exist today. I looked online for the Christian song Hail Haniwa because I wanted to know the exact lyrics to the song but couldn't find it because Chum's Club no longer existed.

I did research on the names of the characters Haniwa and Kofun and found that they were Japanese in origin. I marveled at how the entire subject happened to come up after all these years from my youth in which I had forgotten all about. I have been in the hospital for the last 11 years that I turned my apartment into one. My mind has been changing since then and it is clearly and slowly recalling matters as I can best do. I was talking to my friend Jason Momoa about the show and he explained as best he could regarding the characters that played his children. I loved the whole setup and watched the show with great interest. Even though the topics Haniwa and Kofun used in the apple TV series recall a time period in the Yamato Japanese era it still causes alarm that I am speaking of a time way before I was even born the 3rd to the 8th century in ancient Japanese before they had developed their culture and writing system. I marveled at the Haniwa Sculptures and figurines that mounted the coffins of their dead and surely saw the advancement of the early Japanese.
