21 I saw a new heaven and a new earth, because the first heaven and earth had disappeared, and the sea was gone.

What passage in the Bible expresses the heart condition that was actually inside of people buried deep down that was suddenly reveal? At *Isaiah 11:3-5 (Easy-to-Read Version)* ³ He will find joy in obeying the LORD. This king will not judge people by the way things look. He will not judge by listening to rumors. ⁴⁻ ⁵ He will judge the poor fairly and honestly. He will be fair when he decides what to do for the poor of the land. If he decides people should be beaten, he

will give the command, and they will be beaten. If he decides people must die, he will give the command, and those evil people will be killed. Goodness and fairness will be like a belt he wears around his waist. At the Second Coming of Christ God has quietly looked into the hearts of each one and found this under lying truth that people were afraid to reveal. But by using the qualities above we find that an global inspection of what is within each ones heart and God has provided what is called judgments and gave people the bravery to stand up for what is right and true. The Great Tribulation started by global weather occurrences have helped others to see and fear that God will destroy those that hurt and hinder others. The Rider on the White Horse

¹¹ Then I saw heaven open. There before me was a white horse. The rider on the horse was called Faithful and True, because he is right in his judging and in making war. ¹² His eyes were like burning fire. He had many crowns on his head. A name was written on him, but he was the only one who knew its meaning. ¹³ He was dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and he was called

the Word of God. ¹⁴ The armies of heaven were following the rider on the white horse. They were also riding white horses. They were dressed in fine linen, white and clean. ¹⁵ A sharp sword came out of the rider's mouth, a sword that he would use to defeat the nations. And he will rule the nations with a rod of iron. He will crush the grapes in the winepress of the terrible anger of God All-Powerful. ¹⁶ On his robe and on his leg was written this name: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS

THE Second Coming of Christ is a very important time for all those living on earth because it emphasis the word Manifest as a theme along with the establishment of the Kingdom of the Heavens. In the dictionary the best word to describe manifest would be **Perceptible** = (especially of a slight movement or change of state) able to be seen or noticed. Another word would be **Distinct** = recognizably different in nature from something else of a similar type, physically separate, readily distinguishable by the senses. Yet again another word would be Marked = having a visible mark, clearly noticeable; evident. All these definitions define what the purpose of the Second Coming of Christ means to the world entirely. As re look into the Bible what passage can we find the expresses the manifestation of the Second Coming of Christ? At 1 Timothy 6:13-16 (Living Bible) 13 9 command you before God, who gives life to all, and before Christ Jesus, who gave a fearless testimony before Pontius Pilate, 14 that you fulfill all he has told you to do so that no one can find fault with you from now until our

Lord Jesus Christ returns. 15 For in due season Christ will be revealed from heaven by the blessed and only Almighty God, the King of kings and Lord of lords, 16 who alone can never die, who lives in light so terrible that no human being can approach him. No mere man has ever seen him nor ever will. Unto him be honor and everlasting power and dominion forever and ever. Amen. The key point in this passage explains that God demands that we fulfill all the requirements outlined in the Bible so that your state of worship will resemble Jesus Christ our Lord in all respects so that no one can find fault with the worship you display. At the Second Coming the Christ it will be revealed clearly to all the power of the Kingdom of the Heavens which displays: the blessed and only Almighty God, the King of kings and Lord of lords, ¹⁶ who alone can never die, who lives in light so terrible that no human being can approach him. No mere man has ever seen him nor ever will. With this information told to us in advance we always had the correct idea of what the Second Coming will be like but perhaps our religion did not actually acknowledge this point so that it was not revealed. What additional information can we find in the Bible? At 2 Timothy 4:1,8 (Living Bible) 4 And so I solemnly urge you before God and before Christ Jesus—who will someday judge the living and the dead when he appears to set up his Kingdom— 8 In heaven a crown is waiting for me, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on that great day

of his return. And not just to me but to all those whose lives show that they are eagerly looking forward to his coming back again.

In the modern age the Kingdom of the Heavens has arrived and the first and foremost feature used was beginning Judgment Day. What passage in the Bible defines what the presence of God meant for the entire Earth? At Malachi 3:1-4 (Living Bible) 3 "Listen: I will send my messenger before me to prepare the way. And then the One you are looking for will come suddenly to his Temple—the Messenger of God's promises, to bring you great joy. Yes, he is surely coming," says the Lord Almighty. ² "But who can live when he appears? Who can endure his coming? For he is like a blazing fire refining precious metal, and he can bleach the dirtiest garments!³ Like a refiner of silver he will sit and closely watch as the dross is burned away. He will purify the Levites, the ministers of God, refining them like gold or silver, so that they will do their work for God with pure hearts. ⁴ Then once more the Lord will enjoy the offerings brought to him by the people of Judah and Jerusalem, as he did before. Since the Kingdom's arrival is marked by judgment calls the presence of God is seen making advanced judgments all over the earth. In the video we can see pictures that have been sent to show how God caused amazing acts of judgment all over the earth. In the passage above it explains that the Kingdom of the Heavens expresses the presence of God as: For he is like a blazing fire refining precious metal, and he can bleach the

dirtiest garments!³ Like a refiner of silver he will sit and closely watch as the dross is burned away. The Second Coming of Christ marks the acts of Judgments that address mankind like a refiner that cleanses and washes even the dirtiest of garments. When we see houses falling into the water, whole homes we know that the qualities used to build these homes had not been superior. We also can see that shabby materials were what was used to build that was cheaper and saved money for the builder even if the home was dangerous to live in. That is what Judgment Day truly is an inspection of the entire earth. What passage in the Bible expresses the message that Jesus Christ spoke in the Bible? At Wark 8:34~ 38 (Living Bible) ³⁴ Then he called his disciples and the crowds to come over and listen. "If any of you wants to be my follower," he told them, "you must put aside your own pleasures and shoulder your cross, and follow me closely. 35 If you insist on saving your life, you will lose it. Only those who throw away their lives for my sake and for the sake of the Good News will ever know what it means to really live. 36 "And how does a man benefit if he gains the whole world and loses his soul in the process? ³⁷ For is anything worth more than his soul? ³⁸ And anyone who is ashamed of me and my message in these days of unbelief and sin, I, the Messiah, will be ashamed of him when I return in the glory of my Father, with the holy angels." The key point in the passage is the words of Jesus Christ when he spoke to the crowds in the Bible as he preached in ancient Israel. We can recall the words that express the

condition we find that exists on earth during Judgment day could not have possible came out of any one that listened to Jesus because he said exactly these words: "If any of you wants to be my follower," he told them, "you must put aside your own pleasures and shoulder your cross, and follow me closely. But actually during Judgment Day we find inferior built homes because people had not followed Jesus Christ who said: "put aside your own pleasures". We actually found different homes all over the world that collapsed in minutes they were so poorly made and designed. What is another feature exposed by the Kingdom of the Heavens during Judgment Day? At 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10 (Easy-to-Read Version) 7 And he will bring relief to you who are troubled. He will bring it to you and to us when the Lord Jesus comes from heaven for all to see, together with his powerful angels. 8 He will come with burning fire to punish those who don't know God—those who refuse to accept the Good News about our Lord Jesus. ⁹ They will be punished with a destruction that never ends. They will not be allowed to be with the Lord but will be kept away from his great power. ¹⁰ This will happen on the day when the Lord Jesus comes to receive honor with his holy people. He will be admired among all who have believed. And this includes you because you believed what we told you. In continuing our narrative of Judgment Day under the direction of the Kingdom of the Heavens, we will reveal additional features in part III that recall, define, and express the presence of God.
