God is Light

John 3:19-20
Easy-to-Read Version

¹⁹ They are judged by this fact: The light has come into the world. But they did not want light. They wanted darkness because they were doing evil things. ²⁰ Everyone who does evil hates the light. They will not come to the light, because the light will show all the bad things they have done.

The time has now come to welcome right minded people an invitation into the Kingdom Government of

God. The Mountain of God in which all must go to learn the proper ways of living has been digitally constructed. A test of all the earth using a Great tribulation has passed and divine inspection has concluded, Revelation 3:10. Now the formal introduction of God eternal plan will be explained to people. The passage above John 3:19-20 is the focal point of the future and people everywhere are asked if they want SALVATION. This is the mandate of the kingdom.

The passage opening in John 3:19 *'They are judged by this fact: The light has come into the world.'* has the correct spiritual application in beginning judgment of all the earth. Light was used to dispense judgment throughout the earth. What is the light? By using the Holy Scriptures, we can find this information written for this time. At John 1:9-13 *(The Living Bible)* ⁹ *Later on, the one who is the true Light arrived to shine on everyone coming into the world.* ¹⁰ *But although he made the world, the world didn't recognize him when he came.* ¹¹ *Even in his own land and among his own people, the Jews, he was not accepted. Only a few would welcome and receive him. But to all who received him, he gave the right to become children of God. All they needed to do was to trust him to save them.* ¹² *All those who believe this are reborn!—not a physical rebirth resulting from human passion or plan—but from the will of God.* The information in this passage helps us to see that God arrived in a

specially crafted human flesh but the response of people in general was that of human nature rather than divine acknowledgement. There may be several reasons for this a shadow of disbelief, no spiritual training, limited education, many things cause people to behave in a certain way. The passage expresses that the world did not recognize God in any way, even people of the same race or creed. The first encounter with judgment comes from a direct confrontation with God, the reaction of the people to the divine created person. The question of judgment remains clearly outstanding: how will you react to God?

What is the main purpose of having God on earth? How can we benefit from the Second Coming of divine authority? These questions are within the Bible and by being the light I will explain the information that expresses this. The Bible was the first instance of divine authority on earth and using the character of Jesus Christ to announce the coming kingdom of God. This is spiritually called the Word of God, John 1:1.

What passage in the Bible relays the future of a physical presence of God on earth? At *Luke 1:77-79* {*Easy-to-Read Version*} ⁷⁷ *You will make his people understand that they will be saved by having their sins forgiven.* ⁷⁸ *"With the loving mercy of our God, a new day from heaven will shine on us.* ⁷⁹ *It will bring light to those*

who live in darkness, in the fear of death. It will guide us into the way that brings peace." The information in this passage is the same as Isaiah 2:2-4 in which the Mountain of God is used to instruct and teach people God's way. The main goal of the physical presence of God is to instruct and teach the truth to all. What additional information can we find in the Bible that expresses God's will in providing a physical form that lives on earth? At *Isaiah 9:4-7* {*Living Bible*} ⁴ *For God will break the chains that bind his people and the whip that scourges them, just as he did when he destroyed the vast host of the Midianites by Gideon's little band.* ⁵ *In that glorious day of peace there will no longer be the issuing of battle gear; no more the bloodstained uniforms of war; all such will be burned.* ⁶ *For unto us a child is born; unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder. These will be his royal titles: "Wonderful," "Counselor," "The Mighty God," "The Everlasting Father," "The Prince of Peace."* ⁷ *His ever-expanding, peaceful government will never end. He will rule with perfect fairness and justice from the throne of his father David. He will bring true justice and peace to all the nations of the world. This is going to happen because the Lord of heaven's armies has dedicated himself to do it!*

Despite modern religion being expressed through churches worldwide, the contexts of religious understanding of divine Terminology are muddled, things are not spiritually clear as they

should be. This is the reason for God to come to earth and is called the Second Coming. The first encounter with God is through the Holy Bible. All religions has the guide of the Holy Scriptures to teach them spiritual terminology, if the Holy Bible is not used within the church, then the information for religious principles do not have divine clarity. If an additional book is used other than the Holy Bible as a spiritual guide it is considered a book of philosophy. Only the Holy Scriptures using the Old and the New Testament together is the Word of God. Since human nature has led the way of all life on earth including spiritually, what passage in the Bible tells us how people have developed within the many churches and religious organizations? At *Job 24:13 {Easy-to-Read Version}*

¹³ "Some people rebel against the light. They don't know what God wants. They don't live the way he wants. The information that is of key importance to us the failure of religion to lead its many subjects into accurate knowledge of the Word of God. Despite having the Bible easily provided for the purpose of knowing Gods way, people have not gotten the sense of spiritual terminology. The passage above says that people rebel against the light or the Word of God that gives light to all men. This shows that people are not learning accurate knowledge or understanding of what God wants them

to. It also exposes people of not living the life that God created them to live. Again, human nature has played an important role in teaching and training the churches to observe and follow divine principles in contrast with following the Word of God, Matthew 28:17-20. What additional information can we find in the Bible that expresses the spiritual condition on earth at the End of Days? At *Isaiah 5:20* {*Living Bible*}²⁰ *They say that what is right is wrong and what is wrong is right; that black is white and white is black; bitter is sweet and sweet is bitter.*

God has created a government that will help people to obtain salvation this means to become children of God, as outlined at 1 Corinthians 15:51-54. This will mean physical changes to the body that will create immortality which is also spoken of in symbol at John 4:13-14. This is wholeheartedly the job of the Kingdom of the Heavens. Only God can bestow salvation to humanity which is something humans cannot do on their own. The passage of John 3:19 really expresses the heart condition of people living today "*They loved the darkness rather than the light*" {*The Living Bible*}. Well spiritually this rings bells of alarm and the goal that I have to create a new heaven and a new earth is still forth most in my heart as the will of God. The qualifications must be expounded so that there is

no confusion on how the kingdom will provide salvation. Not everyone will be chosen to partake of salvation why? *"They loved the darkness rather than the light"* So, these people will be found and separated from those that wish to gain the right to become God's Children, Revelation 7:13-17. The best thing to do now is to explain what darkness is using modern terms to describe clearly what is meant. At *1 Corinthians 6:9-10* {*Easy-to-Read Version*}⁹⁻¹⁰ *Surely you know that people who do wrong will not get to enjoy God's kingdom. Don't be fooled. These are the people who will not get to enjoy his kingdom: those who sin sexually, those who worship idols, those who commit adultery, men who let other men use them for sex or who have sex with other men, those who steal, those who are greedy, those who drink too much, those who abuse others with insults, and those who cheat.* Why is it so important to return to this passage and give clarity? *"They loved the darkness rather than the light"* Okay so now people have accepted things that were termed wrong within the Biblical guideline. It became normal and popular to live a certain way as time went on more people accepted a way of life that was not Scripturally sound. So again, we will make clear what is Biblical standards and what will not be allowed to obtain salvation. To quote the Bible clearly with explanation: *those who sin sexually.* In the dictionary the word Fornication is defined as: sexual intercourse

between people not married to each other. Spiritually this means sex with a single person(s), "Fornication" today it is clearly can be termed as prostitution. The terms used such as boyfriend and girlfriend are clearly acceptable terms used instead of Biblically understood as fornication. Living together without a marriage commitment is also a loose term for fornication. In the Bible, these things are unacceptable. To have sexual relations with someone you are not married to is fornication, friends with benefits, one-night stands, working as a prostitute, family members, jobs that lists sexual relations as a qualifications in the contracts, whether it is listed directly or indirectly etc....

"Those who commit adultery". Must also be explained more clearly since the world today is full of sexuality. In the dictionary the word Adultery is defined as: voluntary sexual activity (as sexual intercourse) between a married man and someone other than his wife or between a married woman and someone other than her husband. If two people willingly engage in extramarital affair, is it still unacceptable. Open marriages, menage trois, swinging, calling in prostitutes, affairs, cheating all these and more indicate adultery. In continuing with the passage of 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 it says: *men who let other men use them for sex*

or who have sex with other men. In the dictionary the word Gay is defined as: sexually or romantically attracted to people of one's own sex (used especially of a man). The terms homosexual, queer, lesbian, transgender generally mean same sex attractions. But the passage in the Bible clearly expresses that men have sexual relations with each other and then allowing men to use their bodies for sexual purposes. Today this is a very real problem where innocent men and women are led into gay relationship for work, this means this is how they can obtain a job by engaging in sexual relations. Whether or not people feel same sex attractions, even from their youth it is clearly a sin. Same sex marriages are clearly wrong and divinely unacceptable.

The Bible has already written information to all the people that wish to become servants of God. The main hope is that God will grant salvation which is freedom from imperfection that results in eternal life, Romans 6:23. The character Jesus Christ spoke encouragingly about the kingdom of God, this is the hope that God will finally return to establish the kingdom of the heavens. Building faith in this hope and really believing that a government will be established was the goal of those hoping in the Lord.

The passage at John 3:19-20 expresses: *They will not come to the light, because the light will show all the bad things they have done.*

The passage really shows the heart condition of religion today, either the faith and belief in God's Kingdom was successful among the members of churches or it failed to establish. In any case the result of worship worldwide caused many to reject the light in favor of their course of life. The bad things people are doing have always been on earth and also been exposed in the Bible as wrong. If people wish to do them in spite of Biblical warnings, then that is the blocking course that removes them from the Kingdom. What passage gives us the warning necessary to hope in the kingdom? At *Galatians 5:19-21*

{Living Bible} ¹⁹ But when you follow your own wrong inclinations, your lives will produce these evil results: impure thoughts, eagerness for lustful pleasure, ²⁰ idolatry, spiritism (that is, encouraging the activity of demons), hatred and fighting, jealousy and anger, constant effort to get the best for yourself, complaints and criticisms, the feeling that everyone else is wrong except those in your own little group—and there will be wrong doctrine, ²¹ envy, murder, drunkenness, wild parties, and all that sort of thing. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God. Since the Bible was written for us as an example that teaches Romans 15:4, we have always had the tools that leads us to

being able to approach God when the times finally comes. But one clear point in Galatians 5:19 is that your own ways and thinking can lead into troublesome situations that are expresses in the passage. What additional passage in the Bible can we find that helps us to combat our own thinking that leads to trouble? At *Proverbs 3:5-6 {Easy-to-Read Version}*
⁵ Trust the LORD completely, and don't depend on your own knowledge. ⁶ With every step you take, think about what he wants, and he will help you go the right way.

The most crucial factor about religion on earth is the ability to change one's life and devote towards Christian principles. This should be particularly important to our overall spiritual conquest and a goal towards adjusting our personalities to reflect divine qualifications. Without this basic guidance that the Holy Scriptures emphasis we are bound to wander off in ways that are unholy and morally corrupting. What reminder does the Bible give us? At *1 Peter 4:2-3 {Living Bible}* *² and you won't be spending the rest of your life chasing after evil desires but will be anxious to do the will of God. ³ You have had enough in the past of the evil things the godless enjoy—sex sin, lust, getting drunk, wild parties, drinking bouts, and the worship of idols, and other terrible sins.* The warning of this passage keeps us on course and monitoring our daily actions as a reminder of a

more righteous course of life. The things so common for humans which are within our nature should be guarded against, Ephesians 4:21-24. Remembering that our goal is to become kingdom seekers Matthew 6:33 so that when the time arrives for God presence on earth, we will receive our full reward, Ephesians 4:14 and Romans 12:2. What final Biblical warning does the Bible have that helps us to protect our faith so we can receive the Light of God successfully? At *Ephesians 5:6-14* {Names of God Bible} ⁶ *Don't let anyone deceive you with meaningless words. It is because of sins like these that God's anger comes to those who refuse to obey him.* ⁷ *Don't be partners with them.*

⁸ *Once you lived in the dark, but now the Lord has filled you with light. Live as children who have light.* ⁹ *Light produces everything that is good, that has God's approval, and that is true.* ¹⁰ *Determine which things please the Lord.* ¹¹ *Have nothing to do with the useless works that darkness produces. Instead, expose them for what they are.* ¹² *It is shameful to talk about what some people do in secret.* ¹³ *Light exposes the true character of everything* ¹⁴ *because light makes everything easy to see. That's why it says:*

*"Wake up, sleeper!
Rise from the dead,
and Christ will shine on you."*
