



Psalm 145:15-16 (Living Bible)

¹⁵ The eyes of all mankind look up to you for help; you give them their food as they need it. ¹⁶ You constantly satisfy the hunger and thirst of every living thing.

The passage above shows the condition and the intentions of God in creating and establishing planet

Earth, as it says in the opening words of the Holy Scriptures..... *In the Beginning God created the heavens and the Earth.* The purpose of this address is to acknowledge the responsibility that God had towards the Earth. Since the beginning of the experiment God has allowed humans to decide for themselves what they wanted to do. The time for the end of human nature will resume at the Second Coming of Christ and the establishment of the Kingdom of Heavens on Earth. The Holy Bible has always had information about God's right to rule the world and now it is time to review that information. What does the Bible tell us that expresses to all the responsibility that God will take in relation to planet Earth? At *Psalm 104:13-21 (Living Bible)*

¹³ *He sends rain upon the mountains and fills the earth with fruit.* ¹⁴ *The tender grass grows up at his command to feed the cattle, and there are fruit trees, vegetables, and grain for man to cultivate,* ¹⁵ *and wine to make him glad, and olive oil as lotion for his skin, and bread to give him strength.*

¹⁶ *The Lord planted the cedars of Lebanon. They are tall and flourishing.*

¹⁷ *There the birds make their nests, the storks in the firs.* ¹⁸ *High in the mountains are pastures for the wild goats, and rock badgers burrow in among the rocks and find protection there.* ¹⁹ *He assigned the moon to*

mark the months and the sun to mark the days.²⁰ He sends the night and darkness, when all the forest folk come out.²¹ Then the young lions roar for their food, but they are dependent on the Lord. We have always lived life in this way but it seems that we have not always attributed these things to God. The key points in the passage above is that God has always taken care of the planet in spite of little acknowledgement by people that God continues these things to commerce year after year without end. God is indeed behind the creation of the world and how it operates.

What passage in the Bible tells us how God intended the world to be like? At *Genesis 1:29-30 (Easy-to-Read Version)*²⁹ God said, "I am giving you all the grain bearing plants and all the fruit trees. These trees make fruit with seeds in it. This grain and fruit will be your food."³⁰ And I am giving all the green plants to the animals. These green plants will be their food. Every animal on earth, every bird in the air, and all the little things that crawl on the earth will eat that food." And all these things happened. These verses explain clearly to us what God told the first humans and how they were to feed themselves every day. Even though we have a variety of food to eat the fruits and

vegetables were the main source of food for all live on earth. Animals ate of the grass and leaves of the trees as well as fruits and vegetables they did not eat each other. What passage suggests that food intended for both humans and animals have changed over the years? At *Genesis 9:3-4 (Names of God Bible)*

³*Everything that lives and moves will be your food. I gave you green plants as food; I now give you everything else.* ⁴*"But you are not to eat meat with blood in it. (Blood is life.)* Since the Bible has written this passage as standard law humans have been able to consume animals for food. To this day animals of various kinds have been eaten by people. Today the ocean had lost up to sixty percent of fish since 1970's and many animals have become extinct because of humans either eating the animals or hunting them down and killing them out for a certain part of their bodies for financial gain. Going online what is known to be the perfect food for human beings to maintain overall health? *What is the perfect food for humans? A healthy diet includes the following: Fruit, vegetables, legumes (e.g. lentils and beans), nuts and whole grains (e.g. unprocessed maize, millet, oats, wheat and brown*

rice). At least 400 g (i.e. five portions) of fruit and vegetables per day (2), excluding potatoes, sweet potatoes, cassava and other starchy roots. In the dictionary what does the word **Vegan** = a person who does not eat any food derived from animals and who typically does not use other animal products. eating, using, or containing no food or other products derived from animals. So the proper diet for humans relayed by the medical association would be vegan as it was originally ordained by God at Genesis 1:29-30. Today this type of foods can be very expensive and people may not have the money to buy and consume a vegan lifestyle.

What passage in the Bible explains what happens when the new heaven and earth will be setup? At Psalm 104:24-27 (*Living Bible*)²⁴ O Lord, what a variety you have made! And in wisdom you have made them all! The earth is full of your riches.²⁵ There before me lies the mighty ocean, teeming with life of every kind, both great and small.²⁶ And look! See the ships! And over there, the whale you made to play in the sea.²⁷ Every one of these depends on you to give them daily food. In returning to the original plan when God will take up the responsibility to feed all life on

earth we can count on returning to a healthy and normal vegan lifestyle that promotes a well-balanced mind and body. Spiritual Israel can look forwards to the best the earth can provide with the support of the Kingdom of Heavens and God wisdom in creating the perfect food for all life, Psalms 72:16. What Bible passage supports this kind of life for all chosen ones? At Psalm 136:21-26 (*Living Bible*) ²¹ God gave the land of these kings to Israel as a gift forever, for his loving-kindness to Israel* continues forever; ²² yes, a permanent gift to his servant Israel, for his loving-kindness continues forever. ²³ He remembered our utter weakness, for his loving-kindness continues forever. ²⁴ And saved us from our foes, for his loving-kindness continues forever. ²⁵ He gives food to every living thing, for his loving-kindness continues forever. ²⁶ Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven, for his loving-kindness continues forever. In this passage of the future we know that the name Israel even as it is chosen for the descendants of Abraham who are official called heirs, Galatians 3:29.

What passage in the Bible shows us how the Second Coming of Christ will reflect on all religions on earth? At Matthew 24:45-47 (*Living Bible*) ⁴⁵ "Are you a wise and

faithful servant of the Lord? Have I given you the task of managing my household, to feed my children day by day? ⁴⁶ Blessings on you if I return and find you faithfully doing your work. ⁴⁷ I will put such faithful ones in charge of everything I own!

The key points in this passage expresses that at the Second Coming of Christ God will reward the servants that has completed the commission of caring for the chosen ones every day.

Now this is the key in acknowledging the true faith on Earth, which religion is really from or of God? Which religion was appointed by God as an overseer by divine right? In the passage above it says when Christ returns he will inspect religions of the entire world to see if they are wise and a truly faithful servant that obeyed God always. This can be seen by observing each religious belief that was ever made. The first step is by looking at the holy book that was provided for the religion. By far the Holy Bible can be the only book that is used to lead the church in all ways, 2 Timothy 3:16-17. If another book was used other than the Holy Bible, even if it claims to be of God by using angelic direction it is cancelled out as of God, 1 Timothy 4:1-3. The next step is to take a close look at the

culture that is coming out of each religion since the people will have a way of behaving that will express the belief of each faith, Matthew 15:3-11. The third step in uncovering whether a religion is a wise and obedient servant of God is to see how they influence their worship of God to all that look at them, Matthew 25:6-9. The fourth step is to acknowledge if the religion has taught all the people the message that is in the Bible. If a religion has missed key attribute of the divine message or does not emphasis correct spiritual knowledge they are again cancelled out. When the Second Coming of Christ arrives we will clearly see if religion has followed exactly the plan that God placed in the Bible that expresses the spiritual warning that identifies the arrival of Christ. What passage in the Bible tells us the works that God expects religion to teach and care for the chosen ones? At Psalm 104:28-35 (Living Bible) ²⁸ You supply it, and they gather it. You open wide your hand to feed them, and they are satisfied with all your bountiful provision. ²⁹ But if you turn away from them, then all is lost. And when you gather up their breath, they die and turn again to dust. ³⁰ Then you send your Spirit, and new life is born to replenish all the living

of the earth.³¹ Praise God forever! How he must rejoice in all his work!
³² The earth trembles at his glance; the mountains burst into flame at his touch.
³³ I will sing to the Lord as long as I live. I will praise God to my last breath!
³⁴ May he be pleased by all these thoughts about him, for he is the source of all my joy.
³⁵ Let all sinners perish—all who refuse to praise him. But I will praise him. Hallelujah!

In concluding this address what passage does the Bible have that expresses how people will be when the Lord finally arrives at the Second Coming of Christ? At

Psalm 107:5-11 (Easy-to-Read Version)

- ⁵ They were hungry and thirsty
and growing weak.
- ⁶ Then they called to the LORD for help,
and he saved them from their troubles.
- ⁷ He led them straight to the city where they would live.
- ⁸ Thank the LORD for his faithful love
and for the amazing things he does for people.
- ⁹ He satisfies those who are thirsty.
He fills those who are hungry with good things.
- ¹⁰ Some of God's people were prisoners,
locked behind bars in dark prisons.

"That was because they had fought against what God said. They refused to listen to the advice of God Most High.

The passage above shows the failure of religion created by men to smooth the hearts of those thirsting for truth of God. When the Second Coming of Christ arrives God will take up the responsibility to provide spirituality to all the chosen ones everywhere in the world, Isaiah 2:2-4. As it explains in the book of Revelation 7:9, 14-17 a great crowd of people that comes out of the Great Tribulation will hold palm branches in their hands as they stand before the Throne which symbols that they are ready and willing to follow the Lord, Revelation 14:1-5. What passage in the Bible expresses what is within the hearts of New Jerusalem as the Great Tribulation has come to its end? At

Psalm 132 (Living Bible)

132 Lord, do you remember that time when my heart was so filled with turmoil? ²⁻⁵ I couldn't rest, I couldn't sleep, thinking how I ought to build a permanent home for the Ark of the Lord, a Temple for the Mighty One of Israel. Then I vowed that I would do it; I made a solemn promise to the Lord.

⁶ First the Ark was in Ephrathah, then in the distant countryside of Jaar.

⁷ But now it will be settled in the Temple, in God's permanent home here on earth. That is where we will go to worship him.⁸ Arise, O Lord, and enter your Temple with the Ark, the symbol of your power.

⁹ We will clothe the priests in white, the symbol of all purity. May our nation shout for joy.

¹⁰ Do not reject your servant David—the king you chose for your people.

¹¹ For you promised me that my son would sit on my throne and succeed me. And surely you will never go back on a promise!¹² You also promised that if my descendants will obey the terms of your contract with me, then the dynasty of David shall never end.

¹³ O Lord, you have chosen Jerusalem as your home:¹⁴ "This is my permanent home where I shall live," you said, "for I have always wanted it this way."¹⁵ I will make this city prosperous and satisfy her poor with food.

¹⁶ I will clothe her priests with salvation; her saints shall shout for joy.

¹⁷ David's power shall grow, for I have decreed for him a mighty Son.¹⁸ I'll clothe his enemies with shame, but he shall be a glorious King."
